<u>Canon's Catechism:</u> What significance does the Old Testament have for Christians?

In the Old Testament God reveals himself as the creator of the Universe, the leader and instructor of mankind. The Old Testament is just as much the inspired word of God as the New Testament. Without it, we cannot understand the New Testament properly. The Old Testament is far more than a prelude to the New Testament. In it we find countless prophecies referring to Christ, great spiritual and worldly wisdom, as well as moral instruction. There is also the ancient history of Israel, and a gradual revealing of God to his people. There we also find the book of psalms, which was the prayer book of Christ himself, and is a living part of the Church's daily prayer. There are also many beautiful and instructive stories, such as those of Jonah, Tobit, Job and Esther.
