Diana Johnson MP has tabled an amendment (New Clause 1) to the Government's Criminal Justice Bill, which is coming up for Report stage in Parliament in early March. This St Norbert's ~ Diary Date amendment seeks to change criminal law so that "no offence Spring Fayre on Saturday 13th April in the church hall is committed by a woman acting in relation to her own from 10.00 am to 1.00 pm.
