**Canon Matthew's Catechism**

**How can we hear God when He speaks to us?**

As it says in the First Book of Kings, anyone who wants to believe must have a heart that is ready to listen (1 Kings 3:9). God approaches us in many different ways: in every encounter with another person; in the beauty of nature; in the events of our daily lives. Even in the sufferings of life and the dark times God is speaking to us. He speaks to us even more clearly through the Holy Scriptures and the Catholic Church. The voice of a well-formed conscience is also always the voice of God. He approaches us not as servants but as his friends. Jesus told his disciples in the Gospels that they were not his servants they were his friends. Therefore we should also respond to him as his friends by learning to understand him more deeply, and by talking to him as one friend talks to another.
