Eaglewatch Foundation - Sunday 6th October

The Foundation's mission is to help victims of terrorism in the Middle East. They support mainly Christian and Yazidi families which as a result of ISIS incursion have lost their relatives, homes and everything they owned. Hundreds of thousands of people were forced to flee their homes and towns were reduced to rubble. Yazidi women and children were captured and enslaved. After years some of them were released after ransoms were paid, while others managed to escape. Most of them currently live in IDP camps. The Foundation's work includes projects to reconstruct destroyed workplaces, support for the education of widows and orphans, as well as widely-defined development aid. These activities are not limited to a single, preset field of spe-

cialization as we adapt them to the current needs of the affected communities.

Next Sunday, 6th, at 3.00 pm there will be a meeting in Holy Souls' Parish Hall for Polish speaking and at 4:30 pm for English speaking parishioners in our parishes. At the end of the meeting there will be a collection to support the project.
