

Prayer is the breath of faith, a cry arising from the hearts of those who trust in God. We see this in the story of Bartimae- 🥻 us, the beggar from Jericho. Though blind, he is aware that Jesus is approaching, and perseveres in calling out: "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" (Mark 10:47). Restoring his sight, Christ tells him: "Go; your faith has saved you" (v. 52). This indicates that faith is a cry for salvation attracting God's mercy and power.
