Thirty-second Sunday of the Year**

In the Gospels, Elijah appears with Moses on the Mount of the Transfiguration, bearing witness to Jesus as the fulfilment of the Old Testament prophecies. Elijah's experience of God in prayer culminated when the Lord appeared to him not in wind and fire, but in a quiet whisper.
