Canon Matthew's Catechism: Prayer is God's Gift to us

have decided this year for us to look as part of our commemoration of the Jubilee Year, at the role of prayer in the Christian life. We will explore the Catechism of the Catholic Church and what it says about prayer.

Because of our faith in the one true God of Israel, we are called into a relationship with him, "a vital and personal relationship with the living and true God." (CCC 2558). That relationship we call prayer. The Catechism begins its explanation of prayer by quoting St Therese of Lisieux: "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward in heaven. It is a cry of recognition and love, embracing both trial and joy."

St John Damascene provides us with an alternative definition of what prayer is "Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God." We must also remember that the foundation of all prayer is 🕻 humility. We cannot pray if we are full of pride. We must pray "Out of the depths of a humble and contrite heart." (Psalm 130.1). Only when we humbly acknowledge that we are unable to pray as we ought are we able to accept the gift of prayer and begin praying properly, because prayer is God's gift to us. We begin to pray when we acknowledge that "Man is a beggar before God." (St Augustine Sermon 56).
