St Boniface

We celebrate the feast of St Boniface on 5th June. He is known as the apostle of Germany. He was born in Crediton, Devon, around 675. As a child he entered a monastery in the Diocese of Winchester. However, he felt called to the German missions. At first his mission met with little success. However, after a few years his work prospered so much that in 722 Pope Gregory sent for him, consecrating him Bishop of Germany. When he returned to Germany, he appealed with great success for volunteers to help him in his mission. There was no shortage of conversions. It was teachers in the faith who were lacking. From the 740's Boniface turned his energies to the reform of the Frankish Church (that is the Church in France). He did this at the invitation of King Charles Martel. After many years, when he was over eighty, he returned to evangelise the Friesians. Here Boniface was martyred by the still hostile tribes in 754. One historian has remarked that Boniface had a deeper influence over Europe than any Englishman who ever lived. His tireless energy, and missionary zeal are a testament to the power of the Holy Spirit working within him.

In your charity please pray for

all who have died recently, may they rest in peace. *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.* Please pray for their families at this difficult time; for those whose anniversaries occur at this time; for all who are sick and housebound and those who have no family to support them.
