Livestreaming of Masses

Work is taking place to enable livestreaming of some Masses and Services at St Bernadette's and Holy Souls' Churches Prior to this we are making preparations, in accordance with Section 13.13 of The Parish Safeguarding Handbook, to address potential safeguarding issues for both adults at risk and children.

This includes receiving consent to be filmed/withdrawing consent. Where consent is withheld every effort will be made for the adult/child at risk to participate and be out of view of the cameras. Each week we will publish the services that are being livestreamed and provide services which are not. We will also clearly identify which parts of our Churches are visible on the streaming.

Being able to offer livestreamed services will allow parish ioners, families and friends - who are unable to attend in person - to share in our Liturgies.

Funeral Services and other Services will also b livestreamed, where requested. Further information will be available next week. There will be at least two weeks notice before the livestreaming of Services begins.
