The Sacred Heart of Jesus ~ 27th June

Devotion to the Sacred Heart first emerged in the Middle Ages, as a private devotion. It was given official recognition as a feast in 1675 following the apparitions of Our Lord to St Margaret Mary Alacoque. There is a two-fold aspect to the solemnity we celebrate on this day. On the one hand there is the possibility of making reparation. This is because God's love is frequently poorly responded to and scarcely repaid. Devotion to the Sacred Heart emerges from our consideration that in Jesus, God has a beating human heart, even now in heaven. The secrets of Christ's loving heart have been disclosed to many saints, moving them to foster the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Our Lord explained to St Margaret Mary Alacoque, in a vision, that His infinite love had met with the ingratitude of mankind, especially amongst those who are consecrated to Him in the priesthood or religious life. He asked for a feast to be dedicated to the Sacred Heart; asking on that day that the faithful should make a special effort to receive communion and make an act of atonement.

In your charity please pray for

all who have died recently, may they rest in peace. *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.* Please pray for their families at this difficult time; for those whose anniversaries occur at this time; for all who are sick and housebound and those who have no family to support them.

Livestreaming of Masses Update

Work has begun to install the infrastructure to livestream services at St Bernadette's and will start at Holy Souls' soon. The camera will be located at the back of St Bernadette's Church facing the altar so during the service the Sanctuary and the backs of people occupying the front couple of rows will be visible. The livestream feed is censored to respect your privacy at moments during services such as communion and the children's liturgy, when individuals are at the front of the church.

Participants who will be visible in the Sanctuary during a livestreamed service includes Clergy, Altar servers, Readers, and Eucharistic Ministers so it is important that consent to be filmed/withdrawing consent is obtained. Can parishioners in these roles please collect an envelope in the church porch to complete and return to St Bernadette's Presbytery by 29th June. This will help in our planning of livestreamed and non-livestreamed services from 11th July 2025.

DBS checks
