## St Thomas the Apostle - 3rd July

The feast of St Thomas the Apostle has been moved to July 3rd from December 21st the former feast day, in order to coincide with the translation of the apostle's relics from Edessa. The Syro-Malabar and Syro-Malankara rite Catholics, who were first evangelised by the apostle, and call themselves "Thomas Christians" also celebrate the feast today. In the Gospels of Matthew and Luke the apostle is simply called "Thomas", but in St John's Gospel the Greek name "Didymus" is added, meaning "twin", because that is the meaning of Thomas. He is also known as doubting Thomas, because when Jesus first appeared to the apostles, he was not present, and refused to believe. Later Christ appeared to Thomas and the others, and he made his famous profession of faith: "My Lord and my God." A tradition from Antioch informs us that he preached the Gospel in Persia, and went on to India, where he was martyred His relics now rest in Abruzzi, Italy, which has become a place of pilgrimage. The great relevance of today's feast for us is that a man who was once utterly convinced the Resurrection of Christ was a lie, was through the mercy of God given evidence through the senses he could not refute. This led to faith in the divinity of Christ, and ultimately for Thomas the apostle. a martyr's crown, as he walked off the known map of the world to preach the Gospel.

# Livestreaming of Masses - Update

Work is progressing to livestream services at St Bernadette's Church. A camera has been installed at the back of the Church and the remaining equipment and notices will be in place over the next two weeks ready for the first livestreamed service on 11th July 2025. NB: the camera will not be in operation until this date.

Livestreamed services will be of a fixed view of the Altar and Sanctuary. The backs of people occupying the front couple of rows will also be visible.
