#### St Gregory the Great ~ 3rd September

St Gregory the Great died as Pope of Rome on March 12th 604, afflicted not only by physical suffering, but dismayed by the desolation inflicted on Rome by the barbarian invaders. This feast is celebrated today on the date of his episcopal ordination in 590, to avoid the feast falling in the Lenten season. Gregory was born in Rome in 540, the son of a Roman senator and administrator of one of the seven regions of Rome. Gregory himself became prefect of the city from 573 to 578. After the death of his father Gregory distributed the great wealth of his family among various monasteries and turned the family home into a monastery. In 579 he was sent to Constantinople as the emissary of Pope Pelagius II. Even at the Court of the Emperor he continued to live as a monk. Gregory returned to Rome in 586 and was named abbot of the monastery of St Andrew. He also served as secretary of Pope Pelagius II. On 3rd September 590 he was ordained as Bishop of Rome, having succeeded as Pope. One of the first things he did was to arrange for penitential processions to the seven churches of Centre; preceded by a Eucharistic Service in St Bernadette's Rome in order to pray for the end of the plague of which Pope II Church at 12 noon. He sent missionaries to England and is therefore known as the apostle of the English. He served as Pope for thirteen years, the last two of which were years of intense suffering. The site of his family residence is now a large Church, in which it is possible to see the family dining table, which has now become an altar. He is the one who added the sadly still very relevant words "grant us peace in our days" to the Latin rite Mass.
