**School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies  
(Reception Year)**

Children born between 01/09/2021 and 31/08/2022. The deadline for submitting an application for a school place is **15th January 2026**.

Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you **should also complete a supplementary information form**, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You must also include the supporting **evidence\*** as required with this form, ie a bap-

tism certificate (photocopies are acceptable; contact the parish of baptism if you don't have a copy but please note there may be a charge for this); failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.
