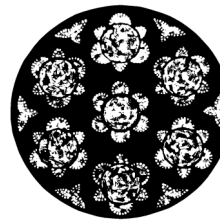

First Reading

Numbers 11:25-29

The Lord came down in the Cloud. He spoke with Moses, but took some of the spirit that was on him and put it on the seventy elders. When the spirit came on them they prophesied, but not again. Two men had stayed back in the camp; one was called Eldad and the other Medad. The spirit came down on them; though they had not gone to the Tent, their names were enrolled among the rest. These began to prophesy in the camp. The young man ran to tell this to Moses, Look, he said, Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp. Then said Joshua the son of Nun, who had served Moses from his youth, My Lord Moses, stop them! Moses answered him, Are you jealous on my account? If only the whole people of the Lord were prophets, and the Lord gave his Spirit to them all! **The Word of the Lord.**

Second Reading

James 5:1-6

An answer for the rich. Start crying, weep for the miseries that are coming to you. Your wealth is all rotting, your clothes are all eaten up by moths. All your gold and your silver are corroding away, and the same corrosion will be your own sentence, and eat into your body. It was a burning fire that you stored up as your treasure for the last days. Labourers mowed your fields, and you cheated them - listen to the wages that you kept back, calling out; realise that the cries of the reapers have reached the ears of the Lord of hosts. On earth you have had a life of comfort and luxury; in the time of slaughter you went on eating to your heart's content. It was you who condemned the innocent and killed them; they offered you no resistance.

Mark 9:38-43.45.47-48

John said to Jesus, 'Master, we saw a man who is not one of us casting out devils in your name; and because he was not one of us we tried to stop him.' But Jesus said, 'You must not stop him: no one who works a miracle in my name is likely to speak evil of me. Anyone who is not against us is for us. 'If anyone gives you a cup of water to drink just because you belong to Christ, then I tell you solemnly, he will most certainly not lose his reward. 'But anyone who is an obstacle to bring down one of these little ones who have faith, would be better thrown into the sea with a great millstone round his neck. And if your hand should cause you to sin, cut it off; it is better for you to enter into life crippled, than to have two hands and go to hell, into the fire that cannot be put out. And if your foot should cause you to sin, cut it off; it is better for you to enter into life lame, than to have two feet and be thrown into hell. And if your eye should cause you to sin, tear it out; it is better for you to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than to have two eyes and be thrown into hell where their worm does not die nor their fire go out.' **The Gospel of the Lord.**

Stained Glass Windows

If you look around the Church you will
notice stained glass windows to honour
the silver jubilee (behind the altar) and
the golden jubilee (the rose window) of
the Church. Should we not consider
leaving a similar permanent reminder of
our centenary year? The matter has been
discussed at the Parish Pastoral Council
and the consensus was that this would be
a fitting idea. We talked about the possi-
bility of two new windows one depicting

our local martyr, St Augustine Webster,
and the other depicting Blessed Pope
John Paul II. We would like the designs
to come from the people of the parish,
with a particular desire to involve chil-
dren/young people. So we invite people
to submit 'sketch designs' featuring ei-
ther one of the two people named above.
Designs need to observe a proportion of
4 parts vertical to 1 part horizontal and
should be submitted by Sunday 4th No-
vember. In due course designs would be
exhibited and people could vote for the
ones they like. These would then be sent
to professional stained glass designers
who would work with them to prepare a
final design.

First Communion

Parents of Year 3 children or older who
hope to make their First Holy Commu-
nion this academic year are invited to a
meeting in the Hall on Thursday 8th No-
vember at 7.00pm. This meeting is for
parents only and details of how the pro-
gramme will run and the level of com-
mitment and participation required from

Confirmation

Bishop Malcolm will celebrate this Sacra-
ment in June 2013. In line with Dioc-
esan policy those who are already at Sec-
ondary school are eligible to be Con-
firmed. A Confirmation Programme, led
by the Reach 4 team from the Briars, will
be run jointly for the two Scunthorpe
parishes beginning in February 2013.
