Holy Week

This is the most important week in the Church's year and all of us are urged to be as fully involved in events as possible.

Part of our preparation to celebrate Easter should include the Sacrament of Reconciliation. If you have not yet been to **confession** there are two further opportunities this week, on **Tuesday evening** we host the Deanery Penitential Service here at Holy Souls. The service begins at **7.00 pm** and all the priests of the Deanery will be present so there will be a selection of confessors available. The final opportunity will be on **Wednesday evening** when Fr Eddy, Fr Benedict, and Fr Wlodek will be available from **7.00 pm to 8.00 pm** to hear confessions. There will be no further opportunities for confession after Wednesday evening.

On Wednesday morning our parish clergy will be taking part in the Chrism Mass at St Barnabas Cathedral in Nottingham. They will renew the promises they made at their ordinations, and our priests will concelebrate Mass with Bishop Malcolm during which the oils used in celebrating the sacraments will be blessed and consecrated. It will be especially moving this year as it will be Bishop Malcolm's last Chrism Mass with us. All parishioners from across the Diocese are welcome to attend, although expect the Cathedral to be packed to capacity. Mass begins at 11.30 am.

On Maundy Thursday we begin our Easter Triduum with the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7.30 pm. This Mass includes the rite of the washing of feet and also the transfer of the Blessed Sacrament to the 'altar of repose' with an invitation for people to stay a while to watch and pray. It is a very moving liturgy and if you have not been before do try and make the effort to attend. As in recent years we will share this Mass (and also the Easter Vigil) with the Polish community.

The main service on Good Friday is the Liturgy of the Lord's Passion at 3.00 pm. This includes the proclamation of the passion, the veneration of the cross, and Holy Communion. Please also note the Churches in North Scunthorpe Walk of Witness which will depart from Britannia Corner at 10.45 am and Stations of the Cross in the evening at 7.00 pm. It would be good if more people were able to take part in the Walk of Witness as an act of public witness in our town of the significance of Good Friday, do give this some thought.

Holy Saturday (note its proper title) is a quiet day in which the Church rests in the hope and anticipation of Easter. However the church building will be a hive of activity with preparations being made for the celebration of Easter, and also the Polish custom of the blessing of Easter food which takes place throughout the afternoon. It is a very colourful occasion and well worth experiencing if you have not done so previously.

This year the **Easter Vigil will begin at 8.30 pm** so that we will begin in darkness, and with no baptisms or receptions we should be concluded by 10.00 pm. On **Easter Sunday** our Masses are at the usual Sunday times of **9.30 am and 6.30 pm**.
