Canon's Ramblings Revisited!

May I express my thanks to everyone who contributed to last Saturday's celebration, whether to the liturgy in Church or to the shared table that followed in the Hall. I thought the evening captured both the rich traditional heritage of our Parish which goes back well over 100 years and also our current reality of being an international community drawn from many parts of the world. I know that Bishop Patrick enjoyed the occasion greatly and I hope that he will have equally happy memories of future visits to our Parish.

It is now a full week since my return from Jerusalem and a number of people have asked me how my trip went and whether I enjoyed it. 'Enjoyed' is perhaps the wrong word in the context of the subject matter we were studying, but I certainly found it challenging and stimulating.

What was it all about? If I had to sum it up after the event I would call it a seminar on 'Christian-Jewish relations in the context of the Holocaust'. Among the topics we studied were 'A history of Christian-Jewish relations', 'The events of the Holocaust' and 'Christian-Jewish relations after the Second World War until today'. We were a group of 18 clergy, ministers, and church workers drawn from different Christian denominations across England and Wales. There were 3 of us who were Catholics, 2 lay people involved in the world of education and myself. Although we had 7 days in the classroom there were also some other activities including a visit to a Synagogue service on the Friday evening followed by a Sabbath supper with local families and also a visit to Christian Holy Sites in Jerusalem, Nazareth, and the Sea of Galilee.

I hope to do a talk and presentation on my experiences, perhaps in the early part of Advent, a Season when some of the issues and questions in Christian - Jewish relations come very much to the fore. If you would be interested please let me know.
