## Lenten Day of Recollection at the Seafarers Centre, Immingham

Saturday 27th February. We will arrange coach transport so that we can all enter the port area together. A coach will depart Holy Souls at 10.00 am returning at approximately 5.00 pm. The cost will be £10 per person. #### Pilgrimage for the Year of Mercy

Fr Eddy is proposing a Pilgrimage to Paris, Nevers, and Lisieux during the October Half Term Week (Monday 24th to Friday 28th October). Visits to the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal and the Shrine of St Vincent de Paul in Paris, to the Convent of St Gilard in Nevers to see the incorrupt body of St Bernadette, and to Lisieux to see the family home, the Carmel, and the Basilica of St Therese. Three nights in Paris and one night in Lisieux. All travel by executive coach from Scunthorpe with no overnight driving. The cost per person on a shared room basis, will be £449. This includes bed and breakfast in Paris and bed, breakfast and evening meal in Lisieux Booking forms available from Fr Eddy.
