Canon's Ramblings

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity concludes on Monday and I hope that people have remembered this intention in their prayers throughout the past week. Why not conclude the week by joining us at St George's on Sunday evening, or even going to Lincoln Cathedral for Evensong where our own Bishop Patrick will be preaching.

Two days later we will mark Holocaust Memorial Day, an annual day of remembrance for those who died in the Holocaust and other subsequent genocides. For us as Christians it is particularly a day to reflect on our relationship with Jews and Judaism. It is interesting to note that in the Vatican and at National level relations between Catholics and Jews have a distinctive profile which does not come under the umbrella of 'other religions' but is more closely associated with the work of ecumenism. This is a reminder not only of the Jewish roots of Christianity but also of the close bonds the Church feels to the living faith of Judaism today as witnessed by the visit of Pope Francis to the Synagogue in Rome last week following in the footsteps of similar visits by St John Paul II and Pope Benedict XVI.
