### Baptisms at Holy Souls

In order for a child (under the age of 5) to be baptised the priest must be satisfied that there is a well-founded hope that the child will be brought up in the Catholic faith. This is best demonstrated by the parents attending Mass regularly and being willing to attend a pre-baptismal programme. The next such event in our Parish, will take place after Easter. For children older than 5 a more complicated process applies, which will also include some catechesis for the child.
