Bishop Patrick will lead our Pilgrimage, which will include our own Mass in the Grotto, a visit to the Baths, participation in the usual processions, and

passage through the Holy Door of Mercy. We have a chartered flight from East Midlands airport, or an overland coach journey, with transfers and insurance all taken care of. Lourdes is the perfect tonic for restoring your faith in humanity, and the Church. If I didn't think it would do you any good, I wouldn't bother inviting you! Bursaries are available for the sick and young people where needed; healthcare professionals are very much encouraged to come too, and bursaries are available.
