Canon's Ramblings

I saw this on one of the noticeboards at Scunthorpe General Hospital, and I share it with you as a tribute to those parishioners who work as nurses or in other caring professions:

Being a nurse means:

You will never be bored,
You will always be frustrated,
You will be surrounded by challenges,
So much to do, so little time
You will carry immense responsibility and very little authority,
You will step into people's lives and you will make a difference.
Some will bless you, some will curse you,
You will see people at their worst and at their best.
You will never cease to be amazed at people's capacity for love, courage, and endurance.
You will see life begin and end,
You will experience resounding triumphs and devastating failures.
You will cry a lot and laugh a lot,
You will know what it is to be human, and to be humane.

It also strikes me that I can recognise a lot of my own life as a priest in those words too!
