The Diocese, under the direction of our Safeguarding Co-ordinator, John Creedon, is in the process of renewing all DBS disclosures which are over three years old. Bishop Patrick has asked all parish priests to remind people that an updated DBS disclosure is essential so that they can continue in their parish ministry. Please co-operate with our parish safeguarding representative, Frances Wattam, should she approach you about renewing and updating your disclosure. All who renew their disclosures are urged to join the DBS update service (free for volunteers) which would mean that they never have to complete another DBS application for ministry in the Diocese.
