The Gospel of Luke on Sundays in Ordinary Time

The Lectionary in the Year of Luke represents faithfully Luke's 'travel narrative' (Chapters 9-19) - Jesus's journey to death, to resurrection and his return to the Father (Sundays 13-31, ie beginning this weekend). Luke's vision of the journey is not geographical or chronological. Rather it is seen as a journey for the whole Church and for the individual Christian, a journey towards suffering and glory. Each Gospel passage should mean a great deal more to the preacher and reader when it is seen in the context of the whole programme of readings for the Year.

With the above in mind this weekend all parishioners will be offered a free copy of the 'Gospel according to Luke'. The book is small enough to put into a handbag or pocket so hopefully parishioners will be able to bring it to church with them as well as using it at home.

Among the normal activities of a week in the parish there were two events that stood out. On Wednesday morning the Key Stage 2 children from St Augustine Webster walked up to the church for Mass. A number of parishioners who were able to join us said how lovely it was to hear the voices of children singing. Hopefully this is something that we will repeat again in the future.

The previous evening I had been invited to attend an 'iftar' meal at the Islamic Centre on Parkinson Avenue. There were a number of other guests there including our local MP and also a BBC film crew from Look North. However I found myself sat next to a young man who told me he was a Year 10 student at St Bede's and then was happy to answer my questions about the Mosque and about how fasting in Ramadan impacts on his daily life. It was a fascinating conversation and I only hope that our own young parishioners would be equally articulate if they were hosting a visitor to our church. If you have Muslim work colleagues, friends and neighbours then fasting and Ramadan can be a good topic on which to begin a conversation about our respective religious practices.
