We have sent donations to the following two charities that work with prisoners: Haven Distribution (www.havendistribution.org.uk/index) and Storybook Dads (www.storybookdads.org.uk/index.html).

The first one supports prisoners' education and the second one helps prisoners stay in touch with their children by enabling them to make story cds/dvds that the children can listen to/watch at home.

Fr Eddy is also aware that there are parishioners with family members in prison. Part of our responsibility as a parish, especially during this Year of Mercy, is to support such families in whatever way is most appropriate. It is often not easy for people to talk about family members who might be in prison, but pleased be assured that the church is here to support and encourage rather than to judge and condemn.

As a church we should also have a special care to pray for Christians imprisoned for their faith throughout the world. The Catholic charity Aid to the Church in Need (www.acn.org.uk) can be a good source of information on this topic.

Pilgrimage for the Year of Mercy
