Confirmation

A reminder that Bishop Patrick will be visiting us on Friday 23rd September to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. We have a group of 20 young people who have been preparing for this Sacrament since January together with a similar sized group from St Bernadette's. Although they will have a break from catechesis over the summer holidays, they will still be continuing their preparation not least through prayer. All

parishioners are asked to support them by joining their own prayers to those of the confirmation candidates. **Candidates and families please note** that the programme will resume on Monday 5th September.

A reminder that parents wishing to have a child (under 5 years old) baptised should expect to give three months notice of their intentions. This will enable sufficient time for the parish clergy to get to know them and to see that they are able to fulfil what they will promise during the baptism ceremony about bringing up their child(ren) in the Catholic faith. It will also ensure that the parents will be able to take part in a baptism preparation evening the next one of which will take place after the summer holidays probably during the month of September.
