Fr Eddy hopes that parishioners are pleased with the new organ. The next challenge is to find a new home for the old organ so that the new organ maybe moved into the existing alcove. This is proving to be quite difficult. We have advertised the organ on an organ builders website but so far only one person has been to look at it and they quickly recognised the same problems that were the cause of our decision to replace it. In the meantime whilst we await a permanent solution we ask people to take particular care as they come to receive Holy Communion on that side.
