Scripture Readings at Mass in Lent. During the first and second Sundays of Lent the Gospel readings are of the Lord's temptations and of the transfiguration, this year taken from the Gospel of Matthew. The Gospel readings for the remaining Sundays will be explained in due course. The first readings are about the history of salvation from its beginnings with Adam and Eve, also including episodes about Abraham, Moses, and David, until concluding with the promise of the New Covenant. The second readings have been selected to fit the gospel and the first readings and, as far as is possible, to provide a connection between them.

Apostles' Creed. The Church encourages us to use the Apostles' Creed during Lent and Eastertide and you will find it printed on the reminders during these seasons.

First Holy Communion Programme. Please collect Sheet 11 this weekend. Classes for children not attending St Augustine Webster school will resume on Wednesday 15th March and **NOT** 8th March as previously stated.
