This Week

Sunday Gospel Readings. For this, and the next two Sundays, we will hear the Gospel readings about the Samaritan woman, the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus. These readings are all taken from the Gospel of John and they are somewhat longer readings than we are usually used to (even if the shorter forms are used). They are used at this time of year because of their importance in Christian initiation and even though we do not have any candidates for the Sacraments this year we can remember in our prayers all those who are preparing to be baptised or received into the church at Easter.
