This Week

Sunday Gospel Readings. We continue hearing the Gospel readings about the Samaritan woman, the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus. These readings are all taken from the Gospel of John and they are somewhat longer readings than we are usually used to (even if the shorter forms are used). They are used at this time of year because of their importance in Christian initiation and even though we do not have any candidates for the Sacraments this year we can remember in our prayers all those who are preparing to be baptised or received into the church at Easter.

<u>Planned Giving Envelopes</u>. New sets of envelopes are now available; please collect yours from the back of Church. If you are a tax payer the envelopes are a means by which we can claim Gift Aid on your giving to the parish. You do not have to give a fixed amount each week, give want you can and the tax man will add to it the tax that you have paid on the money you have given. Over the course of a year our parish reclaims over £3,000 in Gift Aid, this could be significantly more if more people were willing to Gift Aid their giving. CAFOD. We will take a second collection for CAFOD this weekend which we will split between the Lent Fast Day appeal and the East Africa Emergency appeal.
