Retired Priests Appeal

The Diocese has asked that all parishes take a second collection on the weekend of 10th/11th June which will mark the end of the active phase of the Appeal. In our parish this will coincide with the end of Fr Eddy's sponsored walk and will be another opportunity to show our support for this appeal. At the end of this active phase the Diocese will review where we stand in relation to the initial target of £5 million and also where each parish stands in relation to the target they were challenged to raise.
