The other recipient of the award is Brian Harris who has been playing the organ at Holy Souls for 65 years, only interrupted by a two year gap whilst working overseas. Brian received his well-earned award in the Parish on the Feast of Sts Peter and Paul. Our congratulations and thanks to both David and Brian.

### Update on Retired Priests Appeal

Fr Eddy recently received a letter stating that our parish total now stands at £43,275 which is 68% of the target we were set. We have been able to boost our contribution by two donations of £10,000. The first was a donation received from the estate of a recently deceased parishioner with the instruction 'Father, please do with it what you think right' and the second was a transfer of £10,000 from our set off account balance following a discussion at a recent Finance Committee Meeting.
