National Eucharistic Congress 2018

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has called a National Eucharistic Congress to take place in Liverpool from 7-9 September 2018. This will be a unique opportunity for the Church to gather and reflect on the centrality of the Eucharist in our Catholic faith. Although only a few people will be able to take part in the events in Liverpool, Bishop Patrick hopes that there will be a number of related events in the parishes, schools and chaplaincies of our Diocese.

Emergency Responders

Over the past few weeks our news has been filled with a number of tragic incidents that have been declared as emergencies. Here in Lincolnshire the role of the Church in responding to serious incidents is well respected by the Lincolnshire Resilience Forum. To maintain our ability to bring wholeness and healing in these traumatic incidents we need to ensure that as many people as possible participate in the training provided, which gives our response volunteers the skills to behave with sensitivity, but also personal resilience. To that end we are recruiting for our next initial training day to be held on Thursday October 19th 2017 (9.30 a.m. to midday) at Bishop Grosseteste University.

May we ask you to make this opportunity known amongst your churches and, if you feel able, to actively encourage people to attend. We urgently need more people to volunteer to be trained and agree to have their names included on a database, so that we can call on them if a major incident befalls Lincolnshire. While the training is presently focused on Lincolnshire County area, we are working to develop a joint relationship with North and North-East Lincolnshire, so

that they can call on well-resourced individuals in an emergency also.

Clergy Appointments

As announced last weekend Bishop Patrick has made a number of clergy appointments to take effect from September including appointments which will affect our deanery and parish.

Father Gabriel Offor will be leaving the parishes of St Thomas of Canterbury, Gainsborough and St Norbert's, Crowle to take up an appointment elsewhere in the Diocese.

Father Dominic O'Connor will be leaving St Bernadette's and will be replaced by Mgr Tom McGovern who is currently parish priest of SS Peter and Paul in Lincoln. Mgr McGovern will also have care of the parish of St Thomas of Canterbury, Gainsborough.

Father Eddy will be leaving Holy Souls to succeed Mgr McGovern at SS Peter and Paul in Lincoln. He will also succeed Mgr McGovern in his role as Vicar General. The new Parish Priest at Holy Souls will be Father Neil Peoples who is currently an assistant priest at St Mary's in Derby. Father Neil will also have care of the parish of St Norbert's, Crowle. Father Emmanuel Abbem will be remaining at Holy Souls and will assist Father Neil at Holy Souls and St Norbert's as well as being available to assist within the Deanery as necessary.

During the coming weeks the outgoing priests will work with the incoming priests to ensure a smooth transition for all concerned. However the new situation will require a more flexible attitude of mind in regard to cross parish co-operation and almost certainly some changes to weekend Mass times.

Please keep all of us in your prayers at this time so that the new appointments may be an occasion for a real spiritual renewal in all four parishes concerned.
