The summer holidays are often a good time for reflection and naturally even more so this year as I prepare to leave Holy Souls and move to a new appointment. I was fortunate to come here following in the footsteps of a hardworking and conscientious predecessor in Fr John Cahill and so much of what I did was simply carrying on what he and others had done before. If there was one thing I consciously tried to do afresh it was to get more involved in the life of the local community.
