### Canon's Ramblings

I was looking back through the parish registers this week and I was able to work out that during the six years I have been here, I have celebrated 91 baptisms, 21 marriages, and 124 funerals. For me sometimes they can all blur into one, but I realise that these are important family moments for those concerned and I am thankful to God and to yourselves that I have been able to share these precious moments with you as your parish priest. Looking even further back in the registers I could note that in the year I was here as a curate (1993-94) I celebrated 13 baptisms, 3 marriages, and 24 funerals. It has been a particular pleasure meeting some of the people I baptised as infants now fully grown young adults. It has also been good to meet some of the then altar servers, now young men often with families of their own. On the other hand there are a lot of people who don't appear to have changed or aged at all. It must be something about the Scunthorpe climate that keeps everyone young! I feel particularly privileged to have been able to serve at Holy Souls not once but twice as a priest, and I suspect that in my role as Vicar General I may have reason to be here again occasionally. Oremus pro invicem! (Let us pray for one another)!
