### Our Lady of Walsingham Novena – 15th to 23rd September 2017

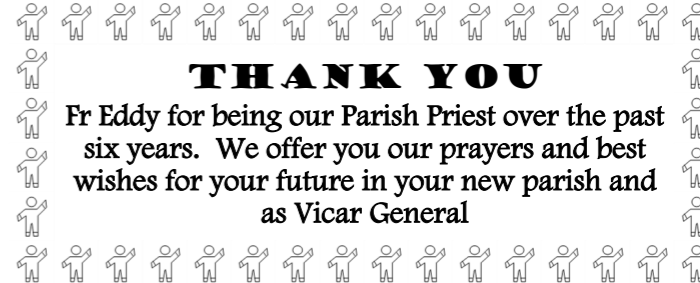
