Adoremus 2018 – Eucharistic Congress in Liverpool

This national event takes place from Friday 7th to Sunday 9th September in Liverpool. It will be a gathering 🄀 of Catholics from all over England and Wales. Most of the events are ticket only and we only have a limited lacktriangleamount. What we know so far:

- Friday 7th September. A Theological symposium and workshops for better forming catechists especially for those leading First Holy Communion courses. This day would also be good for RE teachers and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Cost £40.
- Saturday 8th September. A six hour stage led program based in the 10,000 seat Echo Arena. This will include two keynotes speakers (including Bishop Robert Barron – who did the Catholicism series), time of Adoration and various presentations regarding the Eucharist. Cost £40.
- Sunday 9th September. Pilgrimage Masses some in the Cathedral and others to take place around the City of Liverpool, followed by a Blessed Sacrament Procession through the streets of Liverpool. Free -
